AMERICAN WITH DISABILITIES ACT: CELEBRATING 34 YEARS

July 26th, 2024, marks the 34th anniversary of The Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), which was signed into law by former President George H.W. Bush in 1990. The purpose of the ADA is to create a more accessible environment for people with disabilities. In addition, this federal civil rights law prohibits discrimination based on age, color, national origin, race, and religion. The ADA ensures that people with disabilities are guaranteed the same equal opportunities as those without disabilities in America.

The ADA is divided into five titles:

- Employment (Title I): This title states that employers must provide accommodations for those with disabilities in a work setting. This includes making workstations accessible, providing interpreters, modifying work schedules, policies, and equipment.
- Public Services (Title II): This title prohibits discrimination against individuals with disabilities in all public services and programs on a state and local government level. Public transportation systems are covered under this title and must be accessible as well.
- Public Accommodations (Title III): This title requires public accommodations of facilities such as grocery stores, hotels, restaurants, daycare centers, etc. Barriers of existing buildings must be removed and accommodate those with disabilities.
- Telecommunications (Title IV): This title requires that all national telephone and internet companies provide a telecommunications relay service that accommodates those with hearing or speech disabilities over the phone. Closed captioning and telecommunication devices for the deaf (TTYs) are required under this title.
- Miscellaneous (Title V): This title provides information on the ADA's provisions and relationship with federal and state laws, prohibits retaliation and coercion against individuals with disabilities, and its impact on insurance providers and benefits.







Recreation Corner


